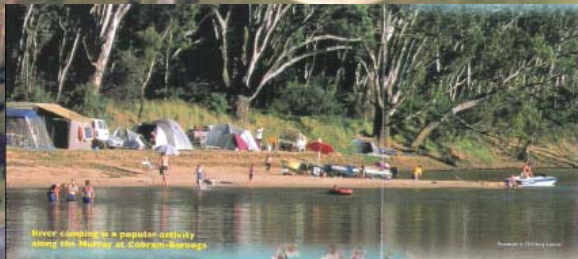
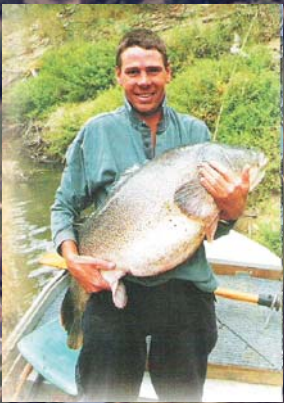




# MASTERS CRICKET

## Barooga and District

### January 18-21, 2010



#### Rationale:

The rationale of the Festival is simple: to re-affirm the enjoyment of the game of cricket with one's peers who are considered to be in the twilight of their careers but for whom the love of the game burns brightly. The opportunity is presented for cricketers, 35 years and older, to continue their passion in a festival atmosphere whilst playing and fraternising with kindred spirits. Highly valued by the Masters' Cricket Festival Organising Committee is the emphasis on friendly competition in games on good quality rustic grounds and top grade turf pitches in an environment that embraces fun and fellowship.

**TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 24th, 2009**

**Costs**

\$400 per team for 3 games:

- 1 \$100 registration fee for a place for team in the Masters Cricket Carnival (subject to availability).
- 1 Balance of payment \$300 to be paid prior to the start of Festival.

**Rules**

- 1 30, 35 and 40 overs per team
- 1 11 players per team on ground at any one time
- 1 all players must be 35 years of age on Monday 18<sup>th</sup> January, 2010
- 1 a maximum of 7 overs for any one bowler
- 1 limited run up of 10 metres
- 1 batsman to retire at 40 runs but entitled to resume their innings when all team members have batted
- 1 last man gets his tucker – bats with runner and if either is run out the team's innings is over
- 1 each team must wear standard cricket whites or an approved cricket uniform as agreed to by the organising committee

**Insurance**

All teams are recommended to carry adequate personal and medical insurance to cover any loss of property, injuries, medical treatment or hospitalisation. The Organising Committee, ground operators and carnival officials will not be responsible for any claims, costs, proceedings and damage whatsoever and however rising directly or indirectly out of, or in connection with its participation in the Masters Cricket Festival at Barooga.

**Prize Money**

Prize Money will be distributed depending on the number of entries. In most cases Prize Money will be suitably proportioned to the top 4 teams. Prize for Most boundaries (4's and 6's) – 'Master Blaster' of the carnival, other individual trophies, Most wickets taken, Most runs scored. The event will only go ahead with a minimum number of teams.

**Grounds and Equipment**

All matches will be played on turf wickets. All teams should provide own cricket playing kit. Cricket balls, stumps and bails provided at all venues

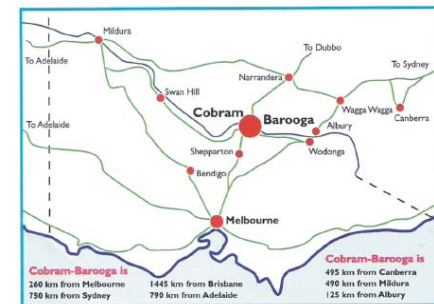
